






Introduction

When you are in Luxembourg, you are in the heart of Europe and all the destinations you would like to explore are just a stone's throw away (almost!). Start or end your trip in the Grand Duchy and discover a fascinating country. Europe opens its doors and you will travel in cities and regions that impress with their diversity and charm.

Luxembourg



Luxembourg is the capital of the small European country of the same name. The rivers Alzette and Pétrusse and their deep ravines cross the city. The capital has a fairy-tale quality to its UNESCO-listed historic core, memorably perched along a dramatic cliff top.


Particularly well known are the remains of their medieval fortifications and the old town. The large cave system of the Bock casemates includes a dungeon, a prison and the archaeological crypt, which is considered the birthplace of the

city. On the ramparts, the “Chemin de la Corniche” promenade offers spectacular views.


Leaving the capital, you rapidly find yourself surrounded by partially forested hills and a string of beguiling villages that form attractive huddles beneath stunning medieval castles. Afterwards there is all the fun of the fizz in Moselle wine country and some loveable walks to take in the pretty micro-gorges of Mullerthal. All in all, this little country has plenty of surprises.

1 day tour

To really explore the richness and secrets of Luxembourg City, have a local, experienced guide accompany you. It is a great way of learning interesting facts about the city, with its unique history, inhabitants, and

traditions. Enjoy a 2-hour tour through the city and discover the most beautiful corners and attractions of the city centre: Place d'Armes, Constitution Square, Government District, Corniche, Monument of the Millennium, Old Town, Grand Ducal Palace (outside), Place Guillaume II and lunch (extra charge) in a typical restaurant in the city.

After lunch you visit the Bock Casemates with your local guide. 17 kilometres of tunnels on different levels and tremendous stairways penetrating up to 40 metres inside the rock face await you here.

After your guided tour, continue sightseeing by a double-decker, open-top bus and discover the surroundings of the city center such as the “Plateau de Kirchberg” with its important government buildings, the European Court of Justice and the Secretariat of the European Parliament or take the “Pétrusse Express” to discover the historic old town of the former “Gibraltar of the North”.

LUXEMBOURG IN 3 DAYS

All-in-one with 2 overnight stays



River Moselle

On our 3-day tour you discover the south of Luxembourg and its wine region “La Moselle”. In the morning you see the blast furnace during a visit of the City of Science. You have the opportunity to get an insight into the urban development of the site Belval, the City of Science and the production process of raw iron. It allows you to understand the urban concept behind this new city quarter, as well as the operation and the conservation of the blast furnaces. The visit starts with a brief introduction in the former industrial building known as the “massenoire”, which is now the visitor and information centre. Subsequently you participate in a guided tour of the neighbourhood before climbing up to a platform with a height of 40 m (180 steps) from which you have a breathtaking view of the new district of Belval and its surroundings.

After this tour, transfer to the River Moselle, the wine region of Luxembourg. Visit of a winery with tasting. The day ends with a river cruise on the Moselle and stunning views of the region.
